<b>Electrical &amp; Power</b>	Feeling <b>unusual heat</b> on outlet covers or smelling “ozone” while dusting baseboards.	Identifies overloaded circuits or arcing wires before a fire occurs.
<b>Life Safety</b>	Checking for <b>corrosion on fire extinguisher pins</b> or blocked sprinkler heads while high-dusting.	Ensures equipment functions during an emergency and maintains code compliance.
<b>Flooring &amp; Egress</b>	Feeling a <b>snag in the carpet</b> or noticing a loose floor transition strip while vacuuming.	Mitigates “Slip, Trip, and Fall” liability and extends the life of the flooring material.
<b>Pest Management</b>	Spotting “frass” (insect debris) or <b>grease rub marks</b> along baseboards during detailing.	Catches an infestation at the “scout” phase before a colony is established.

### 3. Maintaining the “Corporate Standard”

- **The “Tactile” Audit:** Encourage staff to use their hands (safely). A cleaning rag allows a tech to feel a loose bolt on a handrail or a vibration in a ventilation grate that a visual-only inspection would miss.
- **The “Ear” Factor:** Preemptive cleaning often happens in quieter hours. Train staff to listen for the “hiss” of a compressed air leak or the “grind” of a bearing—sounds that are drowned out during peak operational hours.

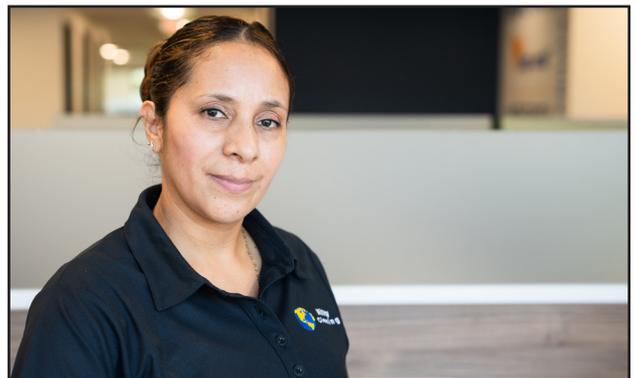
### Why this works
